## A NOTE FROM OUR DIRECTOR

In many Caribbean islands Hello Ocean visited, recycling was not an economically viable option and therefore nonexistent. Cans, plastic bottles, appliances, tires were littering the streets and waterfront. In the US we are lucky in many ways, including our access to recycling. We have the opportunity (or dare I say - responsibility) to take action and help the oceans. That is why I launched Hello Ocean with my husband, Ben.

Hello Ocean kicked off 2015 with a fundraising effort. We asked, we gave, we were rejected, we received, we thanked, and we asked some more. Because of you, we were able to dedicate countless hours, and now we want to share our accomplishments.

# **EXPEDITION UNDERWAY**

Hello Ocean partnered with The Moorings in April to launch our pilot expedition; Expedition Underway. The status of marine mammals in the offshore waters of Belize is largely unknown because no systematic study has been conducted to assess their abundance and distribution. We set sail from Placencia, Belize with the goal to conduct the first offshore marine mammal survey. We held daily marine mammal watch rotations, made aerial drone observations, hydrophone recordings, and collected skin samples for genetic and toxicology study. We also collected marine debris data to support the work of 5 Gyres, and collected water samples for micro-plastic research conducted by Adventurers and Scientists for Conservation.



# **PROJECTS IN DEVELOPMENT**

#### **OCEAN ACIDIFICATION**

Observations show that the CO2 absorbed by the ocean is changing the chemistry of the seawater, a process called ocean acidification (OA). We are partnering with Dr. Nina Bednarsek and Engineer Andrew Street to create a citizen science program that will study the effects of ocean acidification on calcifying organisms.



The Ocean Noise Pollution App will upload data for everyone to share.

#### **OCEAN NOISE POLLUTION**

There is already ample evidence that human-generated noise is impinging on marine life. Ocean Conservation Research (OCR) and Hello Ocean plan to engage the recreational boating community in a baseline, systematic study that will map the world's anthropogenic ocean noise pollution.

## **EXPEDITION DISCOVER**

Our new expedition picks up where Expedition Underway left off by expanding research, conservation, and outreach opportunities via a research-under-sail expedition. The vessel's crew and our partners work side-by-side to extend research and conservation objectives in the field and to strengthen educational outreach through an outreach media series.


